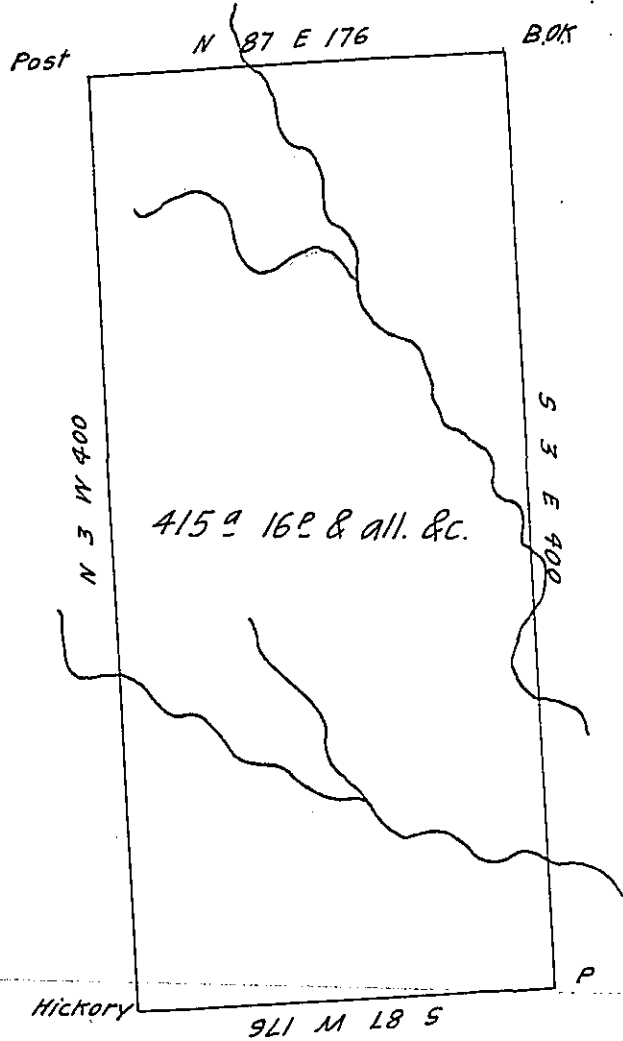

A draft of a tract of land situate on the Waters of Buffalo Creek in Butler County containing four hundred & fifteen acres, sixteen perches & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed 21 June 1808 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Archibald McCall & Michael Fair for 400 acres, dated 12<sup>th</sup> May 1808.
