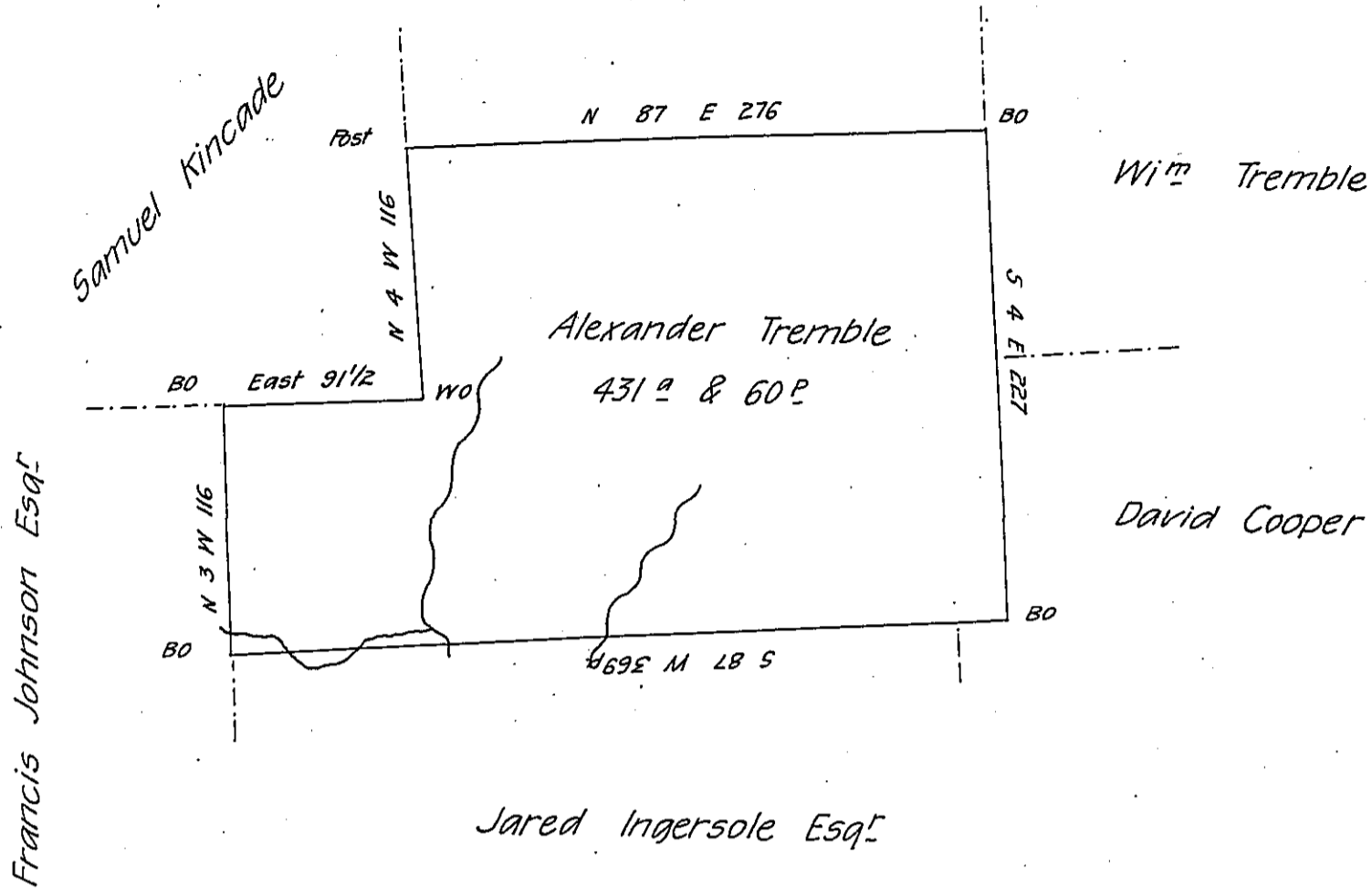


James Tremble
