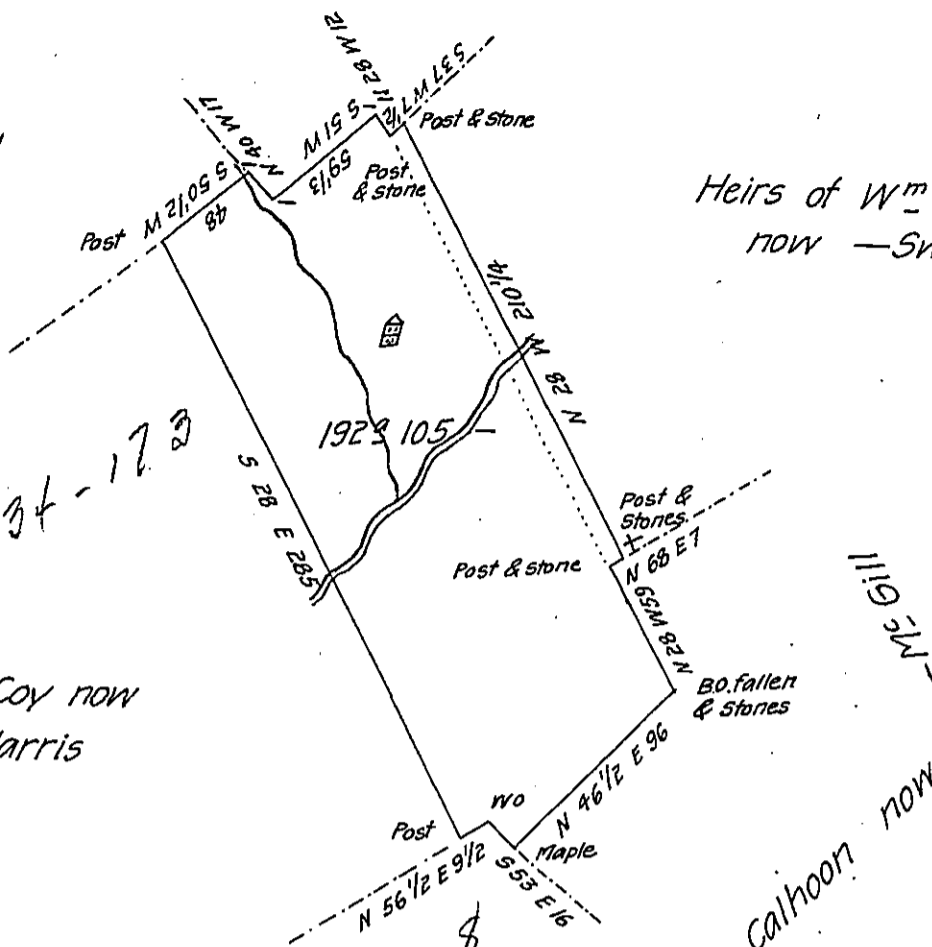

Draught of 192 acres & 105 perches of land with 6 P^c Cent for roads Situate in Fermanagh Township Mifflin County resurveyed Nov^r the 7th 1807 in pursuance of a warrant to Agness Muckelwaine Widow in trust dated November 18th 1762.

Note the strip of land between the dotted line and out line of the survey was originally within the survey of W^m Henderson, which has been altered as above by consent of the Heirs of Henderson & Muckelwaine.
