had been represented unto me by the said Joseph Moyer some years past that the whole of the above tract of land had been surveyed but not returned into the Surveyor General's Office. I was prevailed upon to resurvey the same by the out side lines of the whole tract, as above laid down and which was done May 30th 1766; And after some years discovered that a tract of 153¹/₃^a, and nearly by the lines of the 149^a above, had been surveyed and returned. The said Joseph Moyer upon being informed thereof took out the additional warrant of 70^a in order to secure as well some improvements which he had made thereon as the whole of the said tract as run in the year 1766.
