 18th May 1807 to Jacob Hubler the above described tract of land sit-
 uate on a branch of Bushkill-formerly in Bucks County now in Plain-
 field Township Northampton County containing one hundred and twen-
 ty-nine Acres one hundred perches and the allowance of Six P Cent &c^o
 Surveyed agreeable to old lines found, except the line from the Stone
 to the Chest Oak S. 37. E. 128 being formerly a Barren Hill I could
