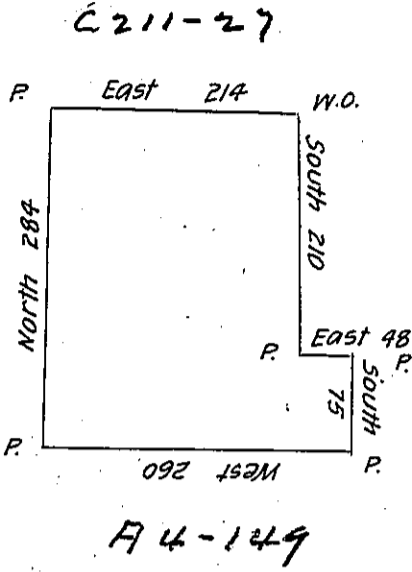

The above is the draught of a survey made December 20<sup>th</sup> 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Rawle on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792 situate northwest of the Ohio River on the waters of Beaver Creek adjoining land granted to Edmund Randolph called Deva- containing 401 acres and 54 perches with the usual allowance of 6 P<sup>c</sup> Cent &c
