



The above draft of a tract of Land was Surveyed October 5<sup>th</sup> 1796 by John Redick under the direction of John Hoge late Deputy Surveyor of a district on the North West Side of the Ohio River) in pursuance of a warrant granted to John McKee dated April 26<sup>th</sup> 1793 situate on the Waters of the Ohio-Containing 401 acres & 16 perches with allowance of 6 per cent.
