



A Draught of an Island Situate in the River Susquehanna called Porters Fishery nearly opposite a place called the Indian Steps on the York County Shore. about twenty perches to the westward of rocky Island. in Martick Township in the County of Lancaster. containing Seven Acres & thirty eight perches strict Measure. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 11<sup>th</sup> of March. 1807 granted unto Charles William Porter.
