



A Draft of a tract of land situated in the Townships of Brushvalley and Cherryhill and County of Indiana, containing one hundred and eighty six acres, fifty eight and five tenths perches and allowance of six percent, for roads, etc. Surveyed for C. W. Keller, Andrew Hoover, Alexander Hoove, Mary M. Schreckengost, S. M. McHenry, G. W. McHenry and R. Eiseman (coal), and John Dean (coal), the 27th day of September, 1904, it being a part of a larger tract of four hundred and thirty two acres, forty eight perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Thomas Patterson dated March 8, 1819.
