



Situate in Shirley Township formerly Bedford now Huntingdon County near Juniata River, two miles from the mouth of Aughwick - Including the Sugar run on the old path from Summervills Mill to Galaways. Including an Iron Ore bank. Containing 400 a.s. 41 p.s. & the usual allowance. Surveyed the 9th day of January 1826. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Green Pollard dated the 4th day of February 1786.
