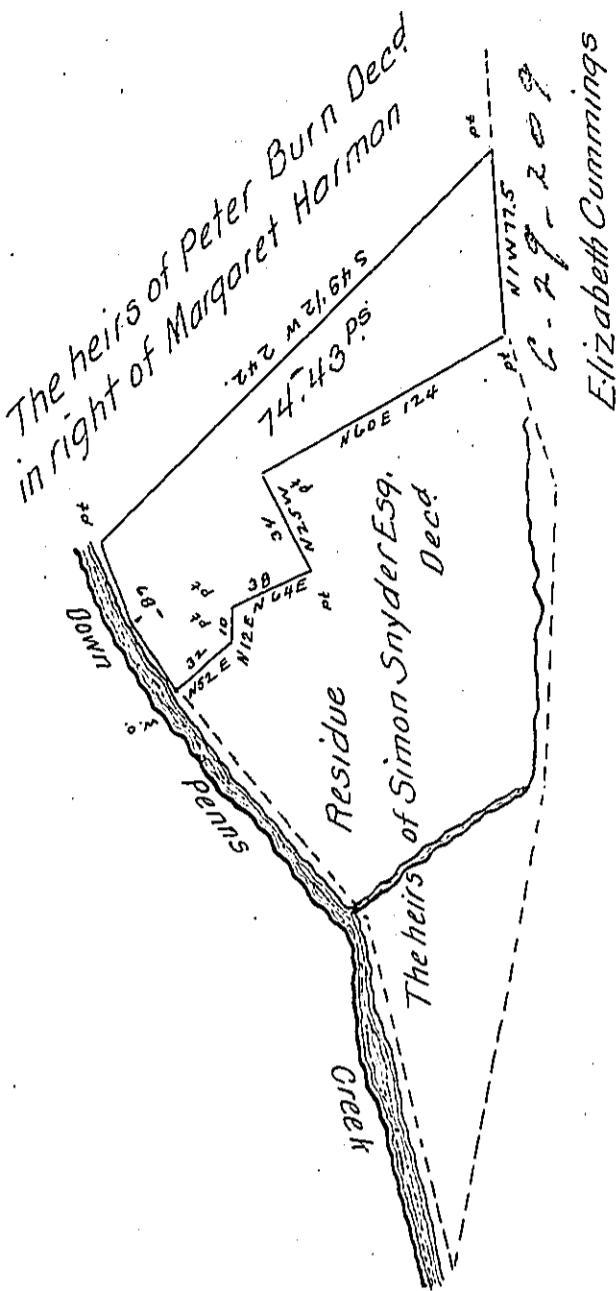

Situate in Penns. township Union County (formerly Northumberland) Surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April A. Dom 1829. for John Ritter Adm<sup>r</sup> &c. of Peter Burn. Containing Seventy four Acres & forty three perches with the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Cent &c.

It being part of a tract of land which was Surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> November A. Dom 1773. pr. William Maclay Esq. then Deputy Surveyor for Peter Burn by virtue of his order bearing Date the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1769. N<sup>o</sup> 2175.
