



Situate in Schuylkill township, Schuylkill county, containing four hundred and one acres and ninety six perches and the allowance of Six per Cent. said to have been surveyed on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1794 in pursuance of a warrant dated 19<sup>th</sup> November 1793 granted Thomas Runyan as appears by an official copy of the return of Survey made into the Surveyor Generals office. Resurveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> September 1826 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1826.
