



A Draught of part of a tract of land called Sparrow-Spring, situate about a mile north from Elias Stowell's adjoining land of John Shaffer & William Stanfield & near Frederick Shaffer in Bethel Township in the County of Bedford, containing one hundred and fifty four acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 21<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1764 for George Rush, in pursuance of an Order No. 1937 dated the 21<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1766 by
