



The Draught of a tract of land called Situate in Penns Valley in Northumberland County. Containing three hundred and twenty one acres and one hundred and twenty two perches with the usual allowance of six acres for Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 1st day of June 1770. in pursuance of a warrant from the Honorable the Proprietaries to John Morgott bearing date at Philadelphia the Twentyfirst day of November Anno Domini 1772.
