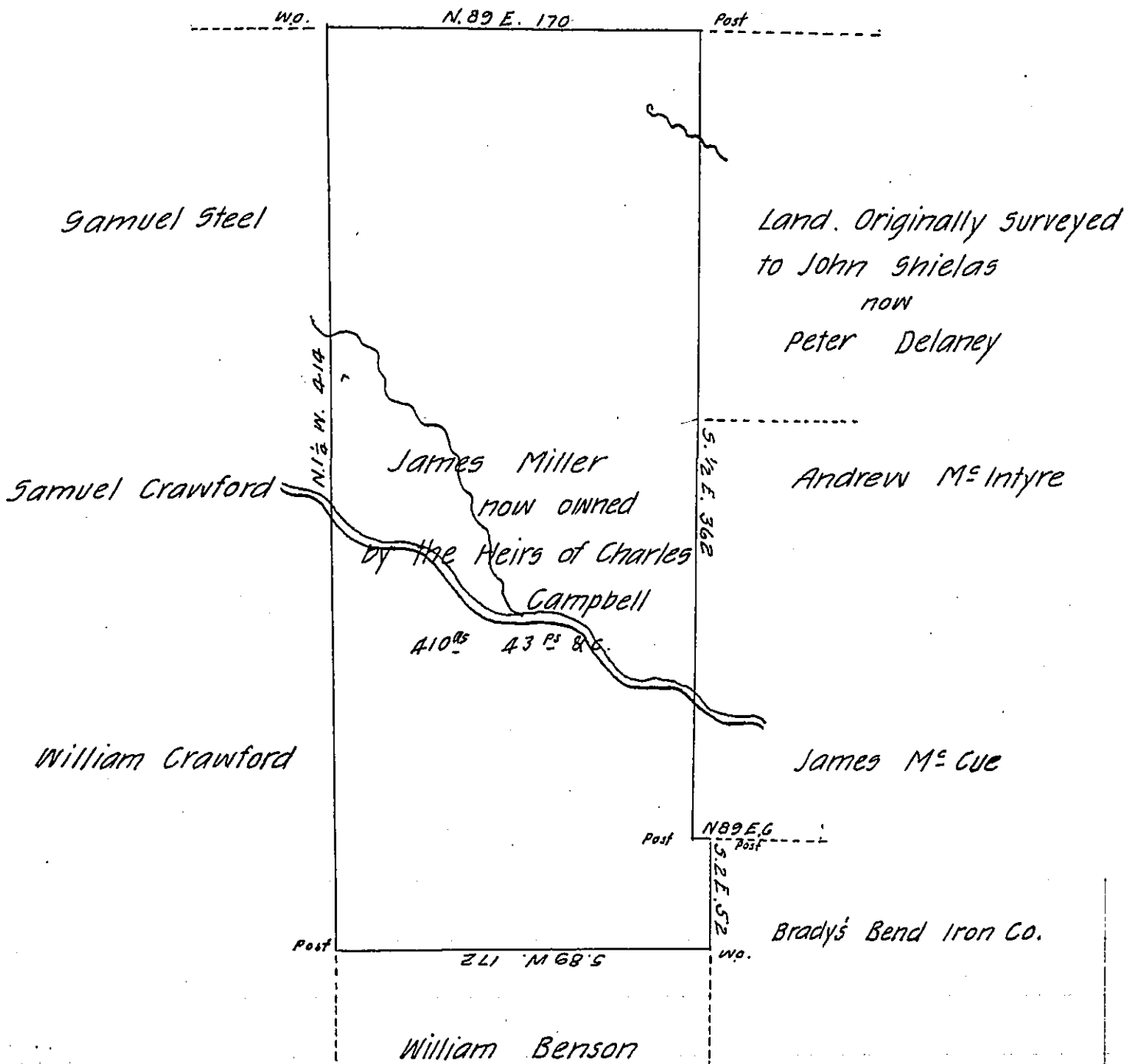


Heirs of John Crawford
