



Draught of two hundred and fifty two acres and one hundred and thirty eight perches of Land with six per cent allowance No. 1 Containing one hundred and seventy nine acres and one hundred and fourteen perches with six per cent allowance, being part of a larger tract situate in Juniata formerly Cumberland County, surveyed on a Warrant to John Mc Knight, dated June 1st 1762. No. 2 Containing seventy three acres and twenty four perches with the allowance was surveyed on a Warrant to Moses Irvin dated March 7th 1855. Surveyed the above into one tract Dec^r 17th 1856 for James Irvin the present owner for the purpose of obtaining a patent.
