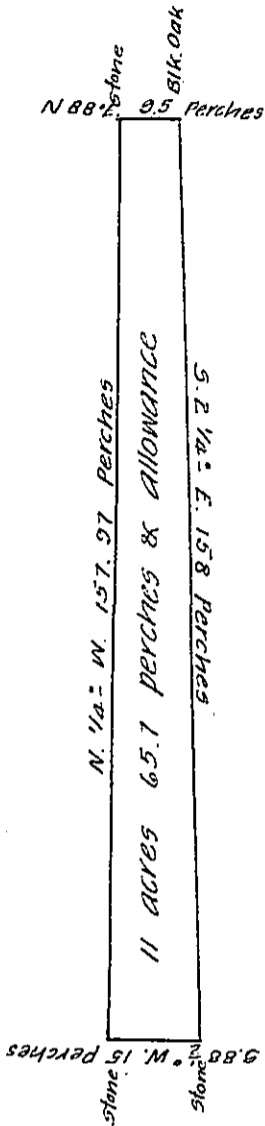

Situate in the township of Shenango Mercer County, Penna. called the "Narrow Vacancy" bounded as above described. Containing eleven acres sixty five and seven tenths perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. which does not appear to have been surveyed or appropriated to any other person - a part of which is fenced and improved - surveyed June 24<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1856.
