



Situate on the waters of Browns Run in German township Fayette County and Surveyed the 6th day of October 1831 In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of John M^sWilliams for 130 acres dated the 21st day of February 1785.

There is about 50 acres of this tract in a state of cultivation, a Brick house, a log Barn and a cabbin erected, and two families residing on it, a small part of the tract was first cleared 40 or 50 years ago, And the principal part of the improvements are of a recent date.
