



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 4th November 1784 & Pursuant to an Order of the Board of Property dated the 4 January 1804 Surveyed the 11th May 1805 to John Nelson the above described tract of land situate in Lower Mountbethel Township Northampton County containing Ninety two Acres 114 perches & the Allowance of 6 pcent &c^o.

N.B. This survey did not satisfy the Heirs of John Nelson without taking a part of a tract returned to Joseph Smith by Warrant of the 2^d Novem^r 1785.
