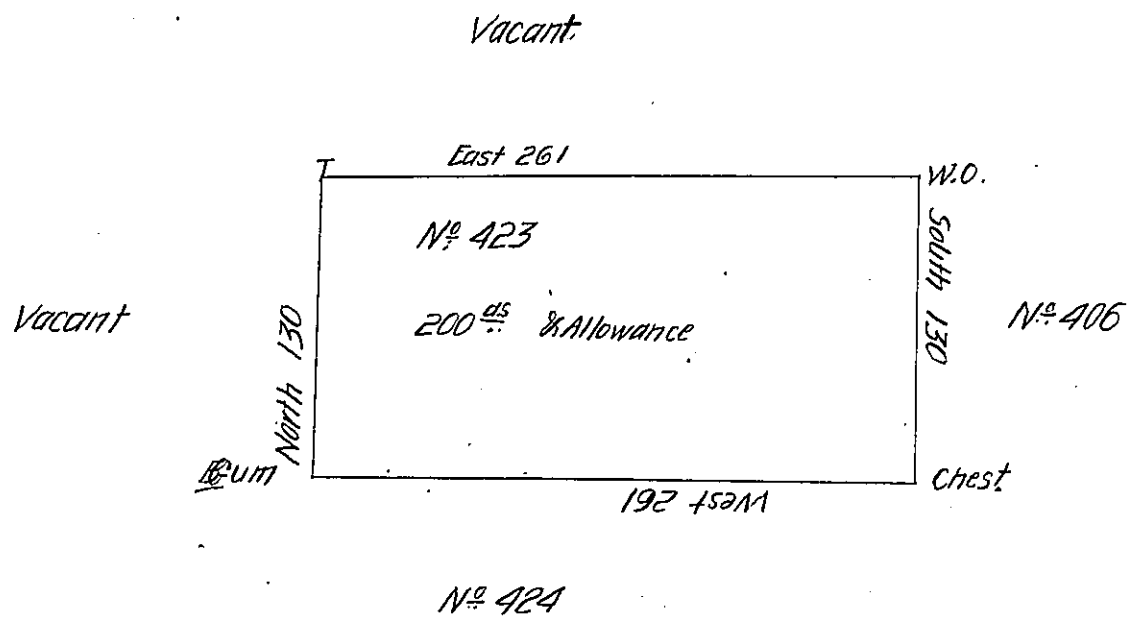

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th Day of February 1785 entitled 'an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the troops of this Commonwealth' and by Order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon^{ble} Executive Council; I have surveyed on the 14th Day of December 1785 the above described tract of Two hundred Acres of Land and the All^{ce} of six P^r Cent for roads. N^o CCCCXXIII situate in District N^o 2. on the West side of Allegheny River in Westmoreland County.
