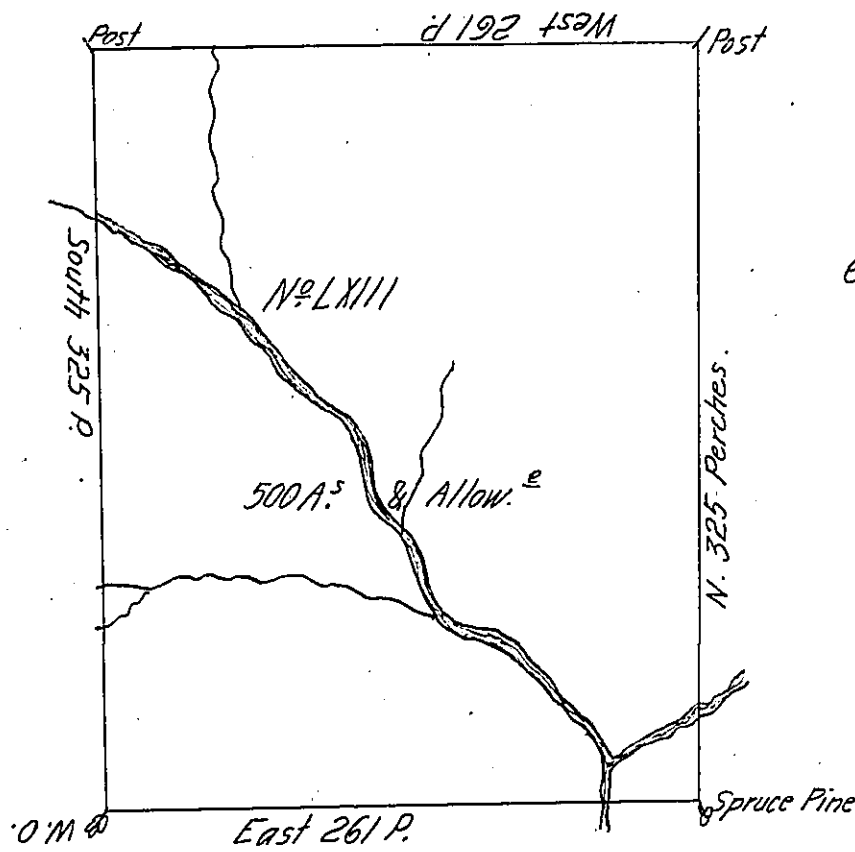

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania Passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of Feb<sup>y</sup> 1785, intitled "an Act for directing the Mode<sup>s</sup> of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this "Common-Wealth," and by order of the Surveyor General, with the Approbation of the Hon<sup>l</sup> the Executive Council, I have Survey'd on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 the above discribed Tract of Five Hundred Acres of Land and Allowance of Six P.C<sup>t</sup> for Roads &c. Nº LXIII- Situate in District Nº 4 on the West side of the Allegheny river in the County of Westmoreland.
