



Situate on the waters of Chest Creek in Allegheny Township Huntingdon County Containing four hundred and five acres and one hundred and six Perches and the usual allowance for Roads &c. originally surveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1800 - Resurveyed and corrected on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of October 1804 In pursuance of a warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 1793 -
