



By Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 29th day of June 1734 Survey'd unto Samuel ~~Scott~~ Scott the 22^d day of July then next Ensuing A piece or parcel of Land situate in Bradford—in the County of Chester. — Beginning at a post being a corner of John Willis's land thence South 24^d East by the land of George Strade of Robt Jefferies Ninety Six Pches & a half to a Black Oak, Thence East North East by the Land of John Davies 155 Pches to a White Oak, thence North 24^d West by the sd. Scott's Land 66 Pches to a Hickory, Thence West by South by the Land of the sd. John Willis 158 Pches to the place of Beginning Containing Seventy four acres, and the usual Allowance for Roads & Highways —

Returned into the Secretary's Office ye 29th day of July Anno Domi 1734. —

Take thy whole fees.
