



Surveyed on the Fifteenth day of (obl.) 1734 to Ulrick ^{Stetter} ~~Stutter~~ a Tract of Land Situate in Salford Township in the County of Philade. Beginning at a White Oak a corner of Christopher Ducks land thence by the same North West Eighty perches to a post thence by land of Martin Hileboidle North East Two hundred & twelve perches to a post thence by land of Andreas Overpeck South East Eighty Perches to a post thence by the Sd. Overpeck South west thirty nine perches and the same course by Valentine Gratts one hundred & seventy three perches to the Place of Beginning. Containing one Hundred acres with usual allowance.
