



Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> of October 1729 As John Taylor says by Warrt. from the late Commissioners dated the 16<sup>th</sup> of May 1714 The above described Land situate on the Western branch of Conestogo Creek in the County of Lancaster now sold to Melchior Erisman alias Michael Erisman but no Warrt. being found to have been granted to Falkner after Melchior's death a Warrt. was issued on the 4<sup>th</sup> of June 1740 to Return this for the use of Edith his Widow.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this Twentieth day of September 1906.
