S., on the 4th day of March A. D. 1768. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 40^a Granted to William Russell bearing date the 4th day of April A. D. 1751. Resurveyed on the 16th day of May A. D. 1811, by the old lines at the request of the owner Ludwick Meyer, who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation.
