



A Draught of a Lot of Ground Situate on the North side of Pitt Street between Juliana and Richard Streets, in the Town of Bedford, in the County of Bedford, marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Eighty three, Containing in Breadth East and West on the North side of Pitt Street Sixty feet, and in length North and South back to the South side of the Raystown Branch of Juniata River, about five hundred and Ten feet, Bounded Southward by Pitt Street aforesaid, Eastward by a twenty feet Alley, Northward by the Raystown Branch-aforesaid, and Westward by Lot Number one hundred and Eighty four. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 21st day of March 1774, for Thomas Smith, Esq^r by Warr^t dated 17th February 1774.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-eighth day of September 1906.
