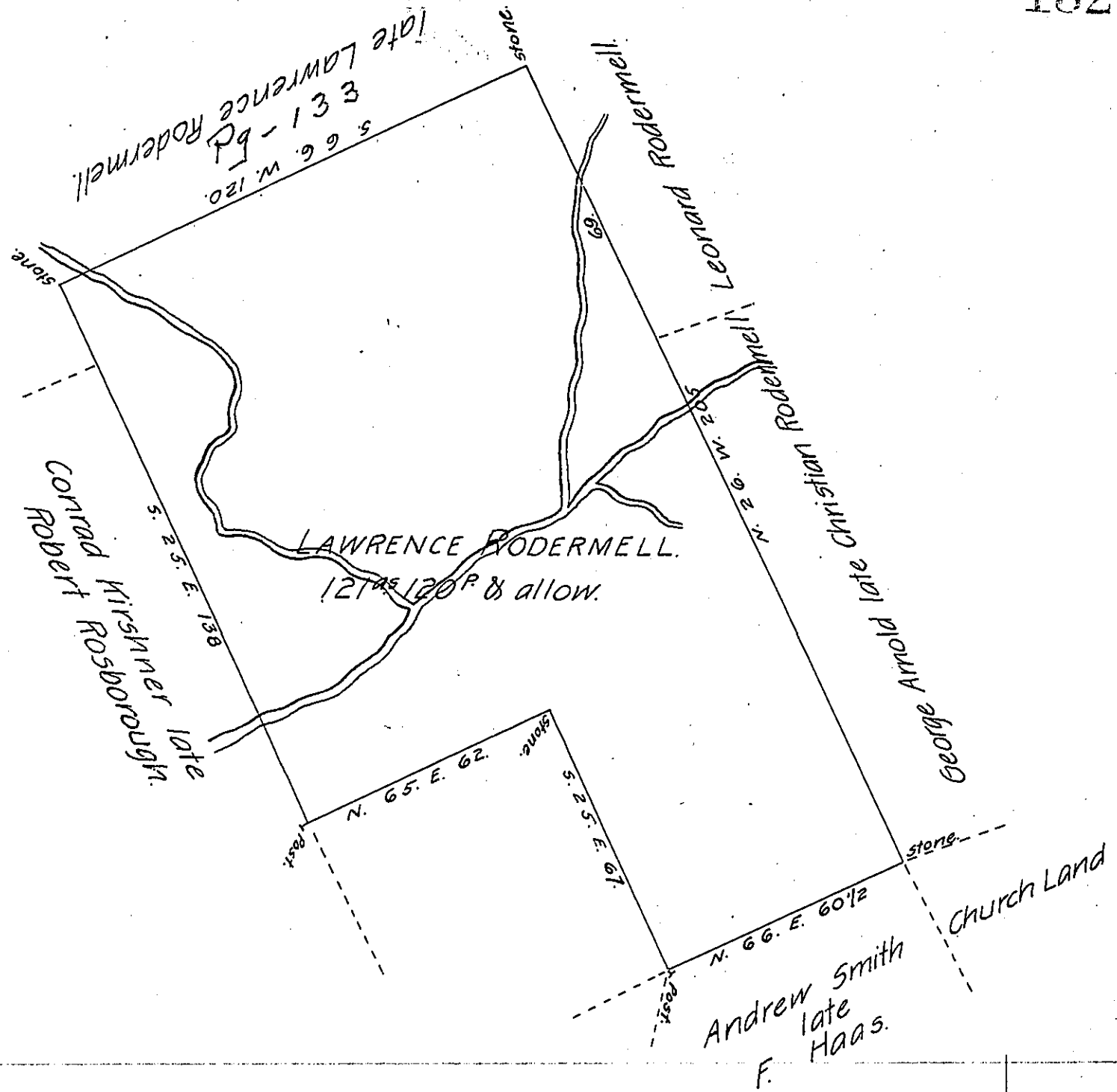

Containing one hundred and twenty one acres, one hundred and twenty perches & the allowance of six per Cent for roads & c<sup>c</sup>, part of a larger tract of one hundred & forty seven Acres & allow. surveyed to Lawrence Rodermell in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> of August 1738. resurveyed & divided the 17<sup>th</sup> of September 1809 for Leonard Rothermel.
