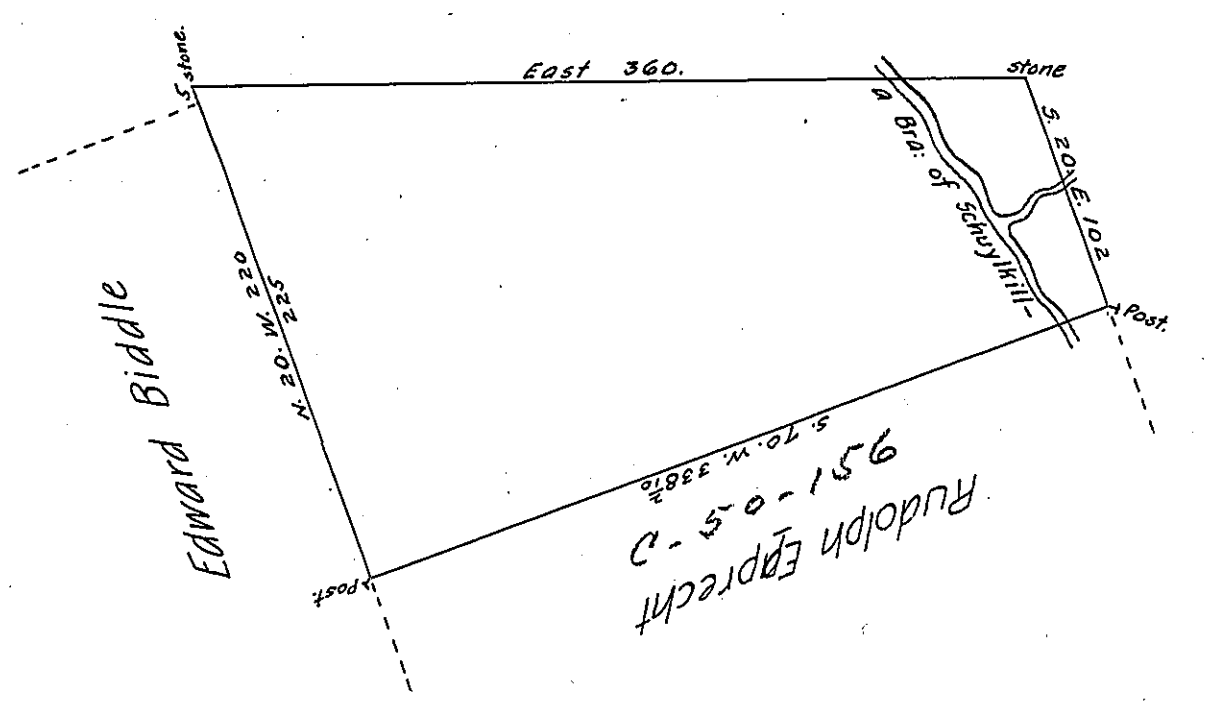


Vacant Land



By Vertue of a Warrant Dated the twenty Second day of November, one thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy three and survay^d the Eighteenth day of 1774 May to Jacob Smith the above Discribed tract of Land Situated over the Second Mountain in Brunswick township, Berks County. Containing three Hundred and twenty Six Acres, and the Allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this tenth day of October 1906.
