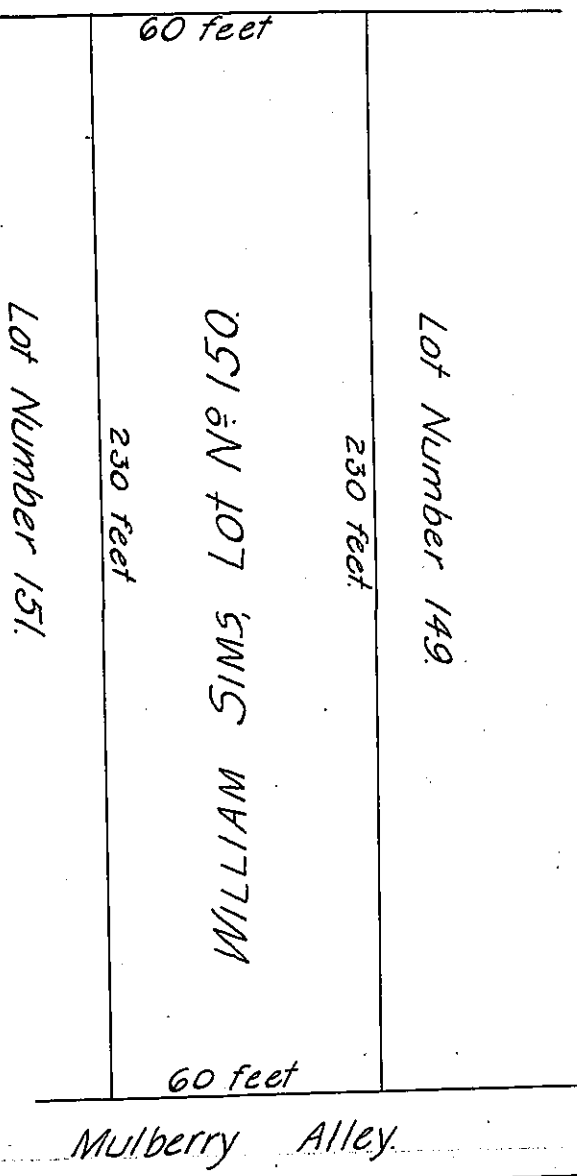

Dewberry Street



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772, a Survey was made on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury, in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town, Number One hundred and fifty. Containing in Breadth East and West on Dewberry Street, Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Northward by Dewberry Street afore said. Eastward by Lot Number One hundred and forty nine. Southward by Mulberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One hundred and fifty One. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October 1774, for William Sims by Warrant dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Instant.—

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-second day of October 1906.
