In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772, a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772, for John Shaw on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury, in the County of Northumberland, marked in a General Plan of said Town, Number One Hundred and Twenty five. Containing in Breadth, East and West on the North side of Dewberry Street, Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred and thirty feet.

Bounded Southward by Dewberry Street, Eastward by Deer Street, Northward by Strawberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and Twenty Six. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 11<sup>th</sup> February 1775, for John Shaw
