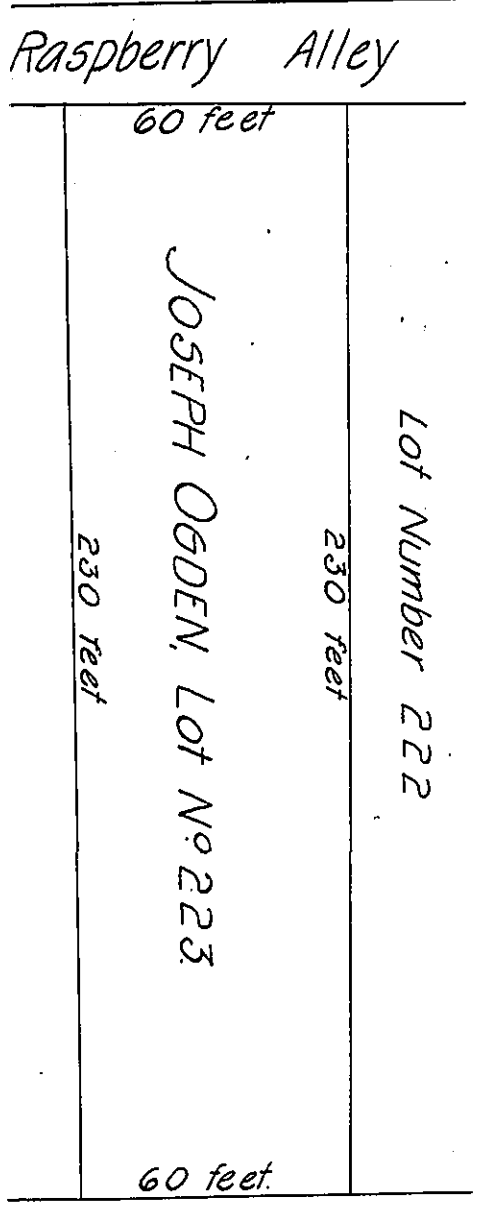

Hurtleberry Street

In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772, a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772, for Joseph Ogden on a Certain Lot of Ground, in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Two Hundred and Twenty Three. Containing in Breadth East and West on Hurtleberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Hurtleberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number Two Hundred and Twenty Two. Northward by Raspberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Two Hundred & Twenty four. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 9<sup>th</sup> day of May 1776 for George Adam Stone.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of November 1906.
