



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772, a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for John Harris, jun^r on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury, in the County of Northumberland, marked in the general plan of said Town No 266. Containing in Breadth East & West sixty feet, and in Length North & South Two hundred and Thirty feet, bounded Southward by Poakberry Street, Eastward by Lot No 265, Northward by Goosberry Alley & Westward by Lot No 267. Returned into the Secretaries Office the 10th day of August 1776 for Stephen Sutton by Warrant of the 9th Instant. —
