



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772, a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for Matthias Teebler on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One Hundred and Sixty three. Containing in Breadth East and West on Blackberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South, Two Hundred and Thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Blackberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number One Hundred and Sixty Two, Northward by Barberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and Sixty four. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 1776 for Daniel Schwartz.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of November 1906.
