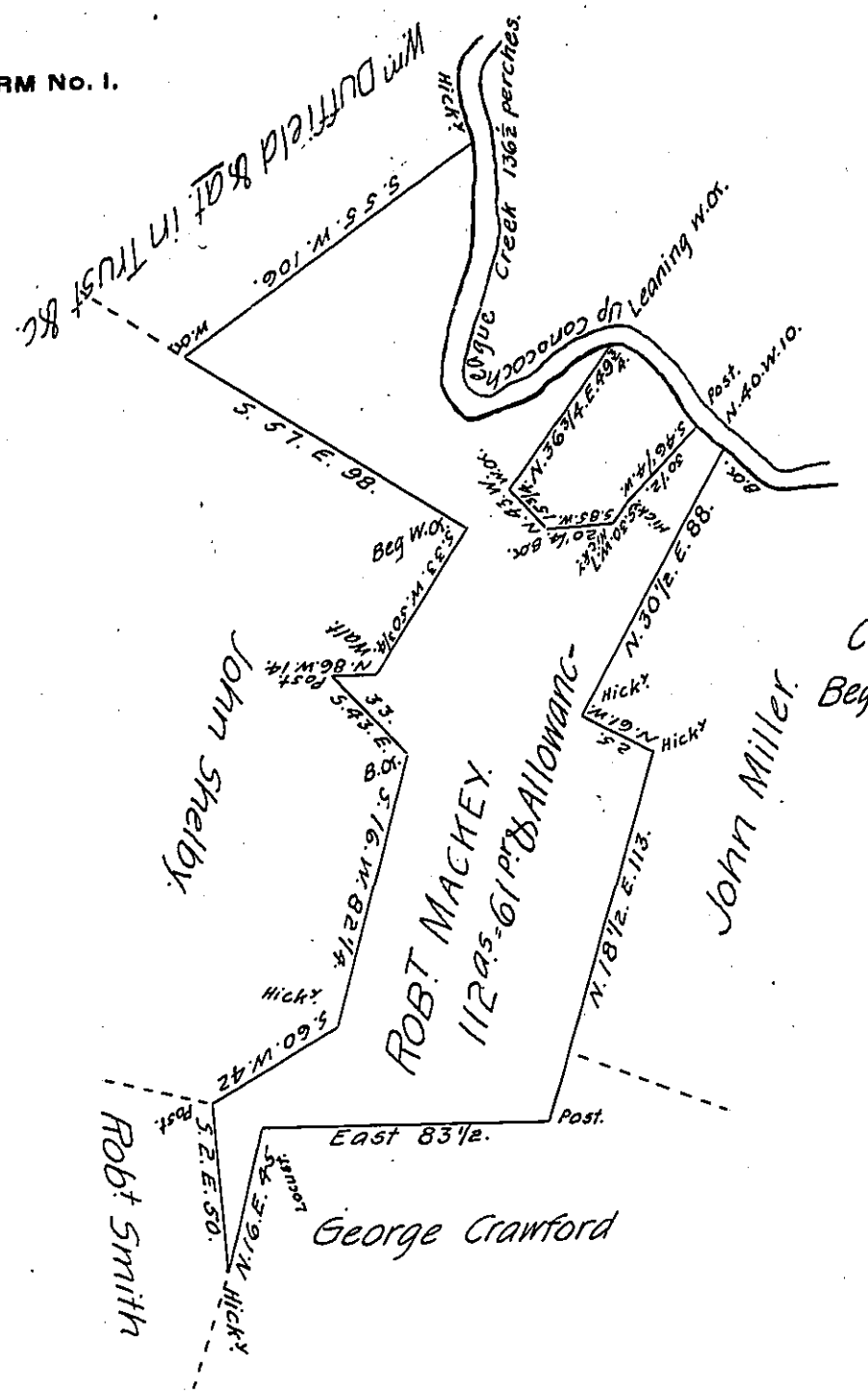

Surveyed April 12th 1774, in persuance of an Order of Survey granted to Robert Mackey Dated January 16th 1767, N^o 2460, by an Assistant of John Armstrongs, Esq^r formerly a Deputy Surveyor, as appears by an official Draught thereof remaining in my office.
