



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acs dated the 21th day of April A.D. 1794 was surveyed the 28th day of January 1817 for Henry Ross the the above discribed tract of land containing 417 acres 118 perches & allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. and that the same was divided as above stated between Stephen Carman & Joseph Clark the assignees of the said Henry Ross for the purpose of obtaining separate patents & at the time of making said survey the said Stephen Carman, was in possession of the same and there appeared to be upwards of 30 acres cleared and fenced and a house fit for the habitation of man. Situate in Venango township Crawford County
