



Draft of a tract of land situate in Scrubgrass township, Venango County, west of the Allegheny river, on the waters of Little Scrubgrass creek, containing one hundred and five acres & one hundred & eighteen perches & allowance. Adjoining land settled by Robert Leason on the south, & John Craig on the east being part of a tract settled by Thomas Barron. Surveyed 30th January 1819 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Cyrus Riggs dated 25th January 1816. Cyrus Riggs is now residing on the tract.
