Note I am authorised to state that there are on the premises the following Improvements viz about 35 acres of cleared land, 100 bearing apple trees. A dwelling house of hewed logs 30 by 22 feet, 1 story and half high. A barn of round logs 46 by 24 feet both under shingled roofs together with sundry other lesser buildings. Which from the character of the owner, I cannot hesitate to believe the statement to be just.
