In pursuance of a Warrant for 100⁰⁵ Granted to Richard Peters, bearing date the 17th day of July Anno Domini 1749. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 18th day of May Anno Domini 1809. for Conrad Snyder the present owner who desired me to make Return of the Draught.
