Surveyed on Warrant granted in the name of John Young; 215 acres 78 perches part of 428 acres 141 perches, Surveyed on warrant granted in the name of Walter Reed; 15 acres 8 1/2 perches part of 399 acres 130 perches, Surveyed on Warrant granted in the name of William Reed; And 165 acres 8 2/9 perches part of 395 acs. 130 ps. Surveyed on Warrant granted in the name of Daniel Young. Examined and prepared for returning the 4th of January 1856.
