Note the Dotted lines thro and to the Eastward of the above draught shows a Survey made the 26th of March 1794. Said to Contain 227.1 Acres & C. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Aquila Burchfield Jur. & James Burchfield, dated June 25th 1793.

An improvement Consisting of a Small Cabin and about four or five acres of Land Cleared now Occupied by John Shaut tis said he has lived there on about four years. yet does not pretend to Claim a Title by Virtue of said improvement.
