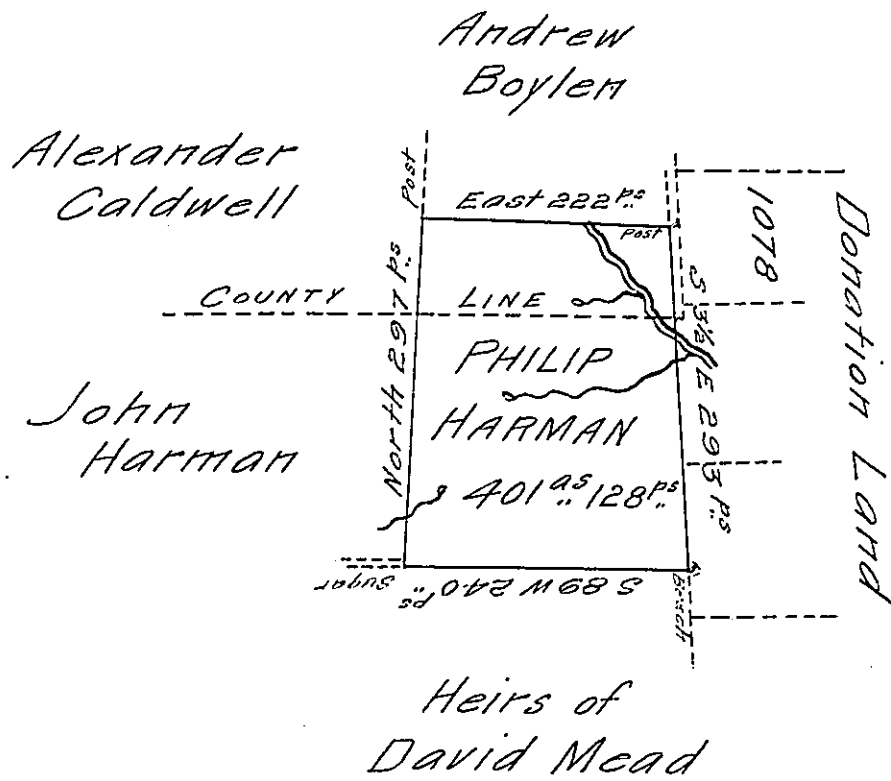


CRAWFORD COUNTY



In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400 acres
 Granted to Philip Harman bearing date the 21th
 day of April 1794 Was Surveyed the 11th day of
 November 1817 the above discribed tract of Land
 containing 401 acres 128 perches and allowance of
 six per Cent for Roads &c. situate part in Fair-
 field Township Crawford County, and part in Sandy
 Creek Township Mercer County, and at the time of
 surveying the same Aaron Boylen was Residing
 thereon and there appeared to be upwards of
 twelve acres Cleared fenced and in a good state
 of cultivation —
