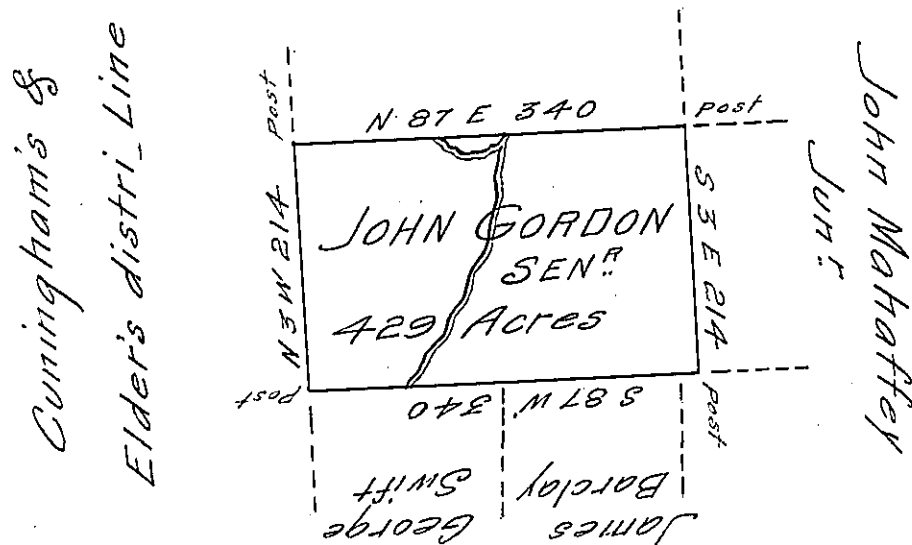


Benjamin Jack
