



A Draught of a Survey call'd the Bank Situate in Allegheny County on the Ohio river, Containing 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> strict measure Surveyed July 10<sup>th</sup> 1785 in pursuance of an entry for 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> granted by the Virginia Commiss<sup>rs</sup> to Jn<sup>o</sup> Laughlin, and duly entered with the County Surv<sup>r</sup> - Note this Survey was originally made and ret<sup>d</sup> in a diff<sup>t</sup> manner as will appear by the draft in the Sur<sup>r</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>'s office the alteration is at the request of the owner and the acceptance without an order of resurvey at his risk also.
