



Situate on the waters of Chest Creek about four miles east of the west branch of Susquehannah River & about six miles South of the mouth of Chest Creek in Huntingdon County containing 405 Acres & 106 perches & the usual allowance for Roads ~ Survey'd the 11th day of August 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the ~~3^d~~^{17th} day of ~~May~~^{June} 1793.
