



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> January 1785 Surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> June 1787 to Abraham Robinson the above described tract of Land Situate on big Bushkill Creek about Six miles from the mouth in Northampton County Containing Four hundred and thirteen Acres thirty three Perches and the allowance of Six  $\frac{7}{8}$  Cent &c.
