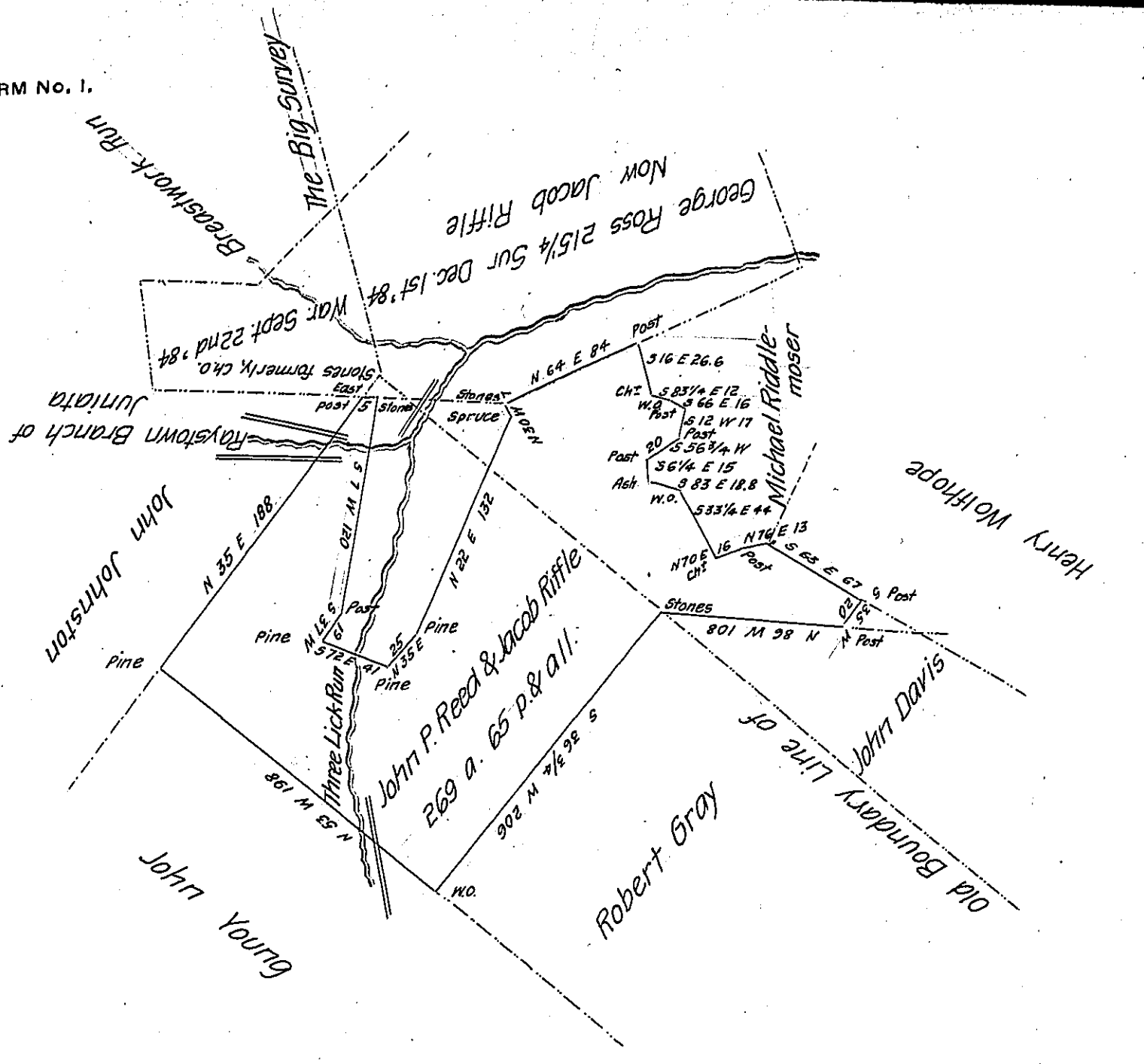

Reed and Jacob Riffle for 290 a. bearing date the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 1843 and certified at the request of the Warrantees the 4<sup>th</sup> day of August 1843
