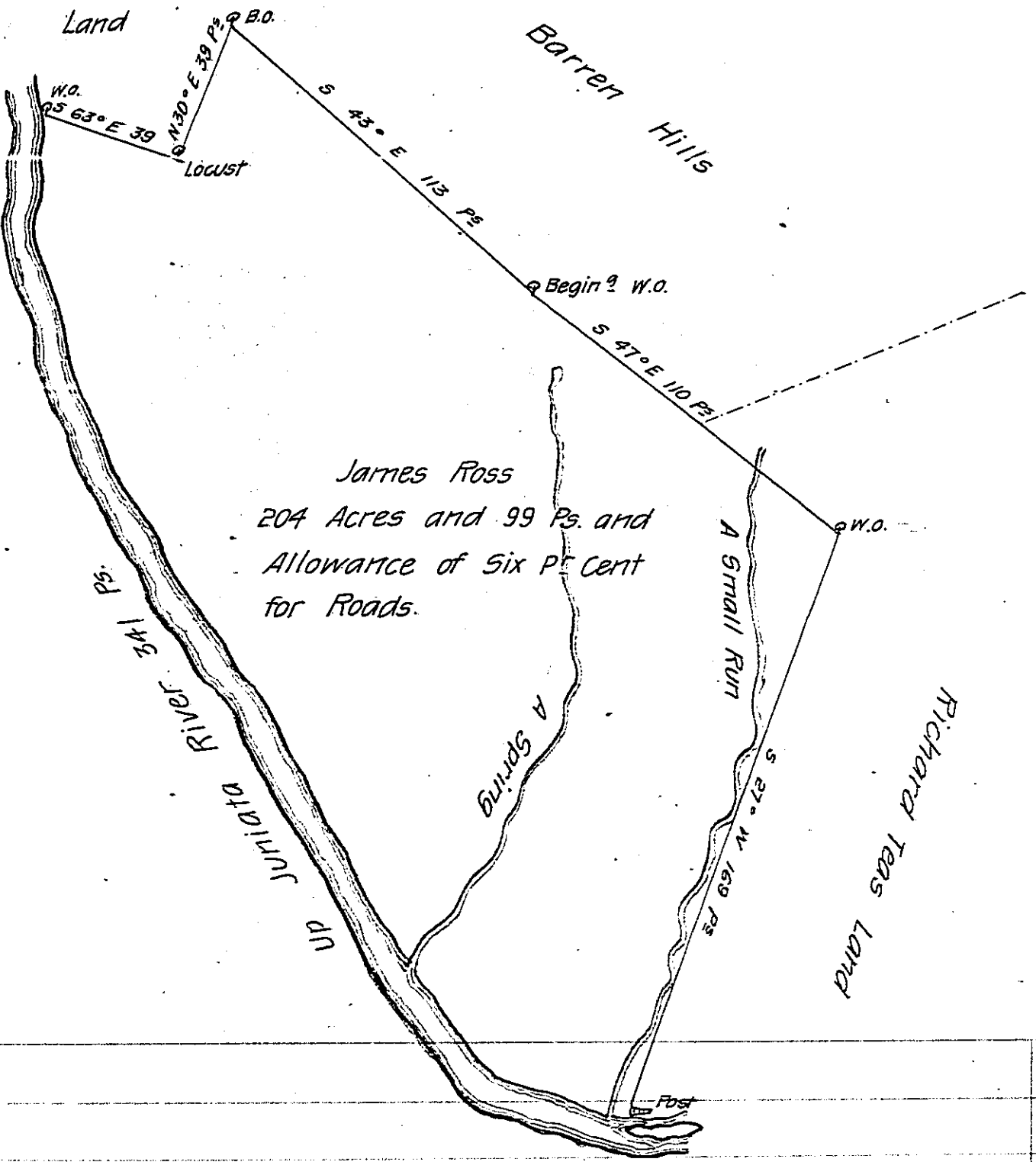

A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on the North East side of Juniata River in Fermanagh Township in Cumberland County Contain- ing Two Hundred and Four Acres and Ninety Nine Perches and the usual Allowance of Six Per Cent for Roads. Surveyed for James Ross November the ~~17~~<sup>16</sup> day 1762 in pursuance of the Honourable the Proprietaries War- rant bearing date the fourth day of October Anno Domini 1762
