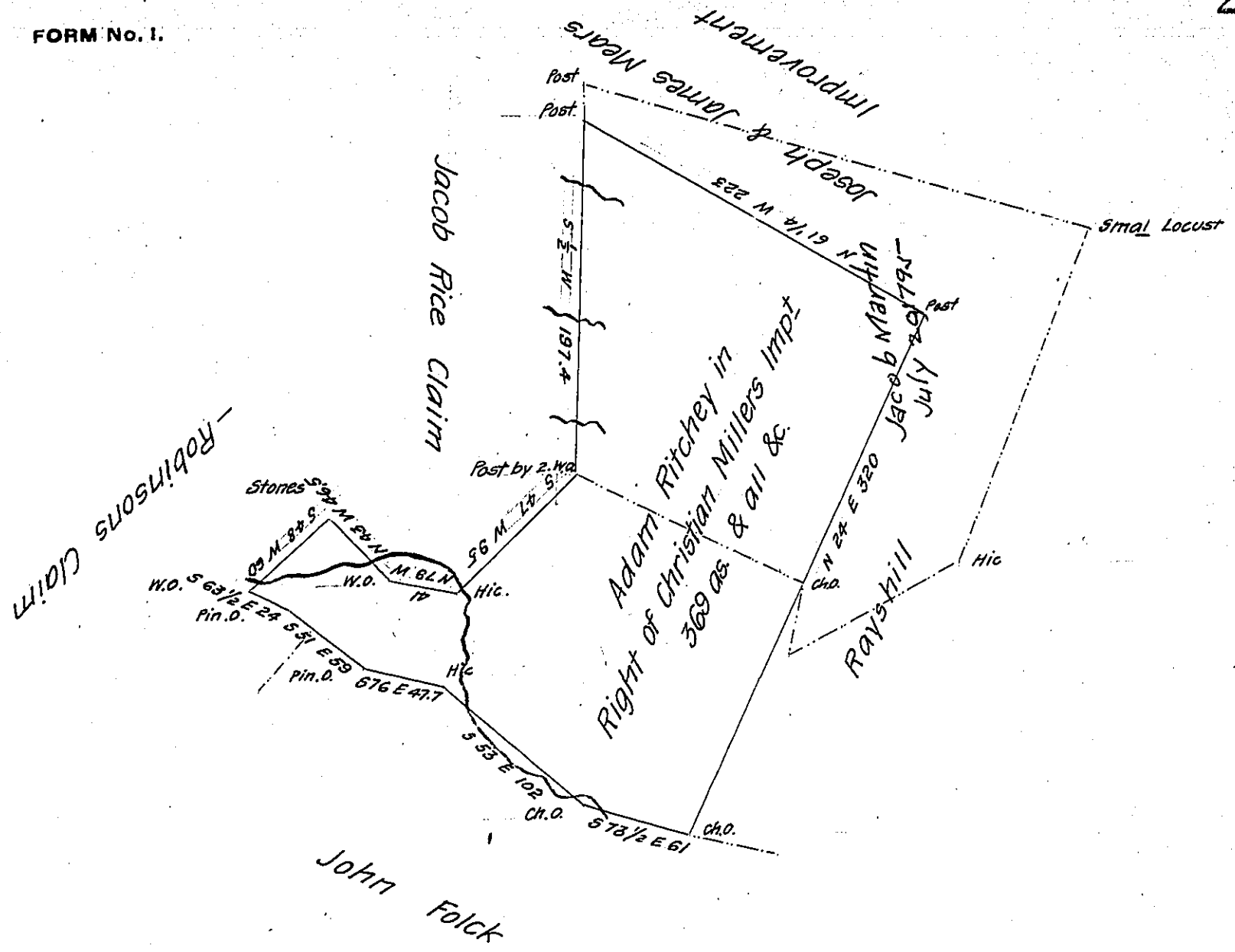

Surveyed the 13th August 1844 on warrant dated the 26th Aprile 1844 granted to the said Adam Ritchey for 336 acres & according to the Original boundry marks of said Improve^{met}

N.B. There is an Actual Settlement and improvement upon the above tract of Land commenced prior to the 28th March 1814. The dotted lines show an apparent interference with a tract of Land surveyed for Jacob Martin the 25th August 1795 on warrant dated the 20th July 1795 Containing 346 3/4 acres. found none of the lines of the Martin tract upon the ground it is not known who now claims the Martin tract or if ever the survey thereon was returned to the land office the Martin tract laid down here according to the adjonders
