



By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietor dated the 26th day of March Anno Domini 1736 the above described tract of land was surveyed unto John Patten in the township of Sadsbury in the County of Lancaster beginning at a hickery in a line of Thomas Smiths land thence north 32 degrees west by William Stuart's settlement to a white oak &c. containing three hundred and three acres beside the allowance of six P cent (7th 1^{mo} 1738)
